How To Take Care of Your Water Supply

- You can prevent water pollution by carefully disposing of the chemical products you use in your home.
- Recycle used motor oil, batteries, paints, solvents, and chemicals.
- Use only the chemicals you need for crops, lawns, and gardens and follow directions carefully.
- Do not put hazardous material down the sink, drains, or toilets. These materials reduce the effectiveness of the septic system and may leak from sanitary sewer lines.
- Never dispose of used motor oil or waste material on your property or in storm gutters or storm sewers.
- Do not dispose of unneeded or expired medications and personal care products by flushing down the drain or toilet.
- Do not pour gasoline or diesel fuel on ant beds.
